Who can apply?

The course is intended for adolescents aged 15-22, who have completed elementary and comprehensive school, who live in Åland, and/or:

- are under temporary protection (e.g. refugees from Ukraine)
- are asylum seekers registered at a refugee reception center
- are not eligible for financial support from Ams

Course content and attendance

The aim of the course is to prepare the students for further studies and to contribute to their successful integration into Ålandic society.

The course focuses on communication through reading, listening, speaking, and writing. The course also covers English, culture and social studies, as well as physical education.

Language practice is included in the course in the form of study visits and other study preparation activities.

We assist in applications for further studies at the end of the course.

Course hours are from Monday to Friday between 10.00-14.00 + 1-2 self-study hours per day. Students are expected to attend all course sessions.

Free of charge

The course is free of charge. Students do not need to pay for neither the course nor the material. As a student, you are covered by Medis accident insurance during school hours.
